## Performance Programme

### Criteria for Showjumping Squad

All riders must be eligible to compete for Great Britain and hold a current British passport. To be eligible for the programme they must become full competing members of British Showjumping on selection and **reside in Scotland**. Riders will not be eligible for this programme if they are currently supported by the BEF World Class Programme. Riders that are currently serving a ban from competition as a result of a doping offence (equine or human) or equine medication offence will not be eligible. The age criteria should be met as to your age on the 1st January 2017, when the programme starts.

Applicants should include the relevant British Showjumping printouts to support their initial application.

#### 16 - 21 year olds

- Rider/Horse combination jumping successfully over tracks 1.40m and above of relevant experience on the correct performance pathway for Nations Cups and European Squads

#### 22 years and above

- Rider/Horse combination jumping successfully in national/international competitions exceeding 1.45m

#### Exceptional Applicants

Exceptional applicants competing on ponies/horses may be considered that meet the following minimum criteria:

- Rider/ Pony combinations, jumping successfully over tracks 1.25m and above and of relevant experience on the correct performance pathway towards Nations Cup, European Squads

Development Squad criteria is just under this level and endorsed by the Olympic Discipline.
